In 1925, Winnie-the-Pooh made his first appearance in a Christmas story in the *London Evening News*. The following year, *Winnie-the-Pooh* was published and was an instant success, as was *The House at Pooh Corner* in 1928. Since then, Pooh has become a world-famous bear, and Milne's stories have been translated into sixty-two languages.

E.H. Shepard was born in London in 1879. He won a scholarship to the Royal Academy Schools and later, like Milne, worked for *Punch* magazine as a cartoonist and an illustrator. Shepard illustrated many books for adults and children, including Kenneth Graham's *The Wind in the Willows*. His witty and loving drawings of Winnie-the-Pooh and his friends in the Hundred Acre Wood have become an inseparable part of the Pooh stories and the illustrations have become classics in their own right.
