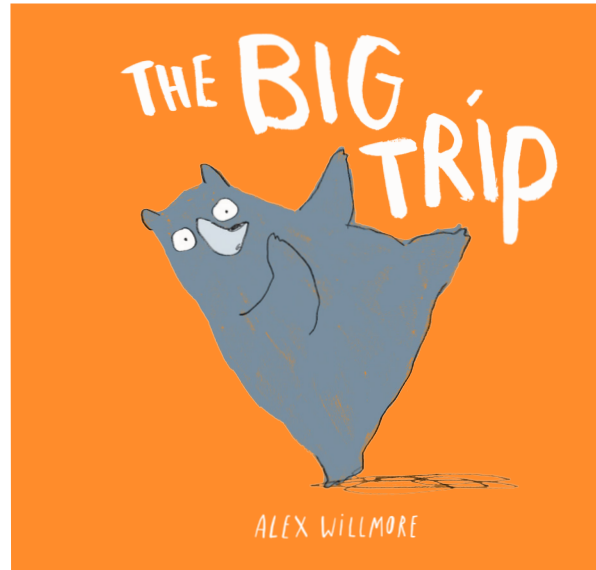
The Big Trip is a brilliantly funny tale about what can happen when we forget to think of others and watch where we're going...
