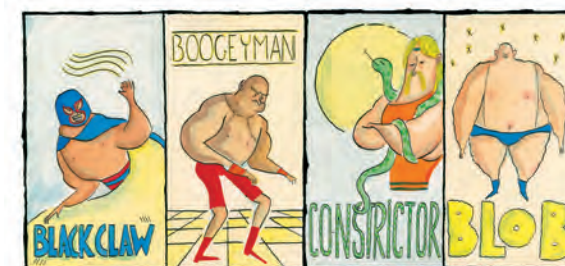

AUTHOR BIOGRAPHY

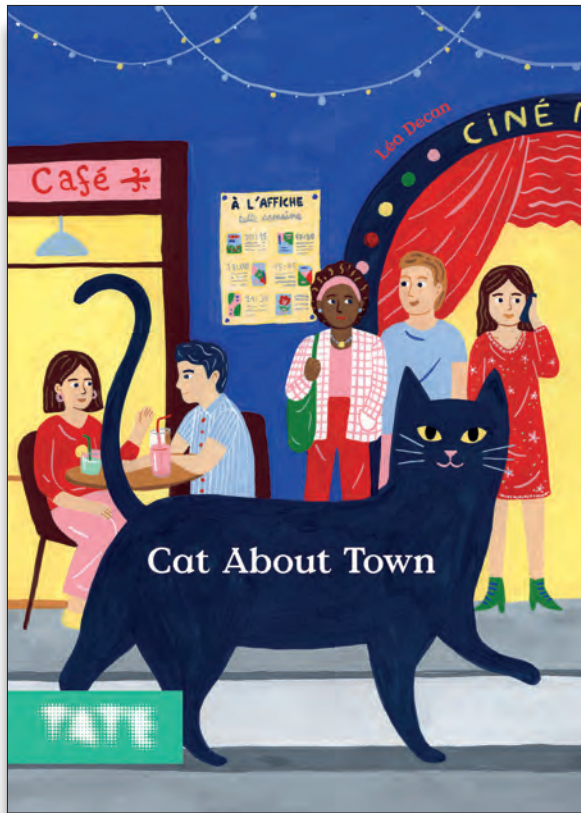
