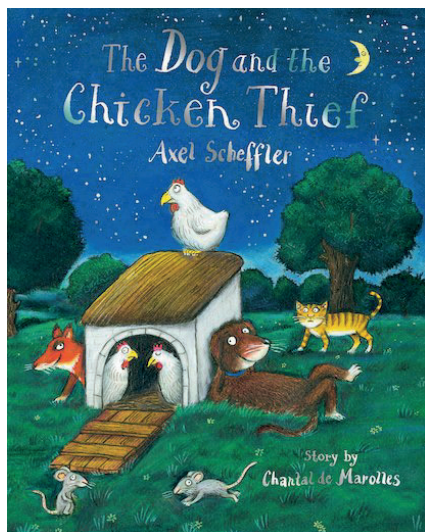

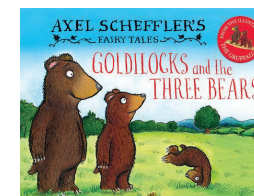

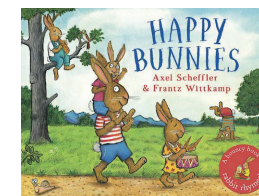

"Ssssscram!" hissed the mice. "And never come back again!"

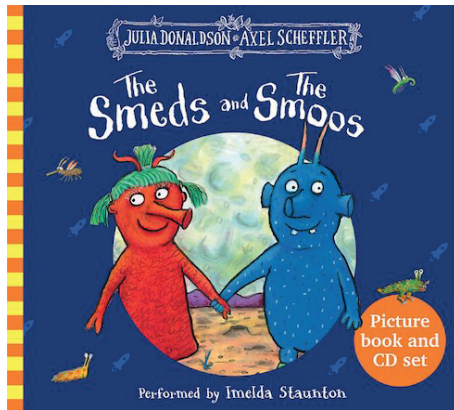
