# AVERAGES

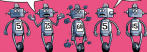
An **average** is a typical value in a set of values. It might be, for example, the average daily temperature in a week or the average number of **pizza deliveries** a robot has made in a month.

THAT'S A LOT OF PIZZAS!

A **mean average** is the total of all the values added together, divided by the number of values there are.

MY PROGRAMMER SAID I WAS VERY AVERAGE.

WELL, THAT'S A BIT MEAN.



$$5 + 25 + 60 + 5 + 15 = 110 \quad 110 \div 5 = 22$$

So, the mean number of pizza deliveries made a month is 22.

The **median** is the middle value in a list. To find it, you write all the values out in order from smallest to largest, and choose the value that lies in the middle.

MOVING IN THE MIDDLE? WHAT A CO-MEDIAN!

5 5 15 25 60

So, the median number of pizza deliveries is 15.

The **mode** is the value in a list that appears the most often. So, **five pizza deliveries** is the mode average.

To find the median in an **even number of values**, place them in order, add the middle two values together and divide the result by two.

5 15 15 20 25 40

$$15 + 20 = 35$$

$$35 \div 2 = 17.5$$

So, the median is 17.5.

THEY ALL LOOK THE SAME TO ME!



Values in a list that are much smaller or bigger than all the others are called **outliers**. They can distort a mean average, making it strangely high or low.

When you have an outlier in a list, it's best to use a median average to get a more typical average figure.



OH, JUST IGNORE BOB. HE'S SUCH AN OUTLIER...

Take these figures for the number of tasty megabytes that **each robot munched** through in a week:

7 12 5 3 60 9 6

60 is much bigger than all the other figures, so you should use the median average to find the typical number. Don't forget to reorder the numbers!

3 5 6 7 9 12 60

The median average is 7 because it is the middle number in the range.

Here's a way to remember **each type of average**: mode sounds like 'most', median sounds like 'medium' and 'mean' is the one that's left!

The **range** of a list of values is the difference between the smallest and largest numbers.

Let's say the GigaSmart2 BrainBot Academy has a quiz night.

The team scores were as follows: 6 25 17 9 16 30.

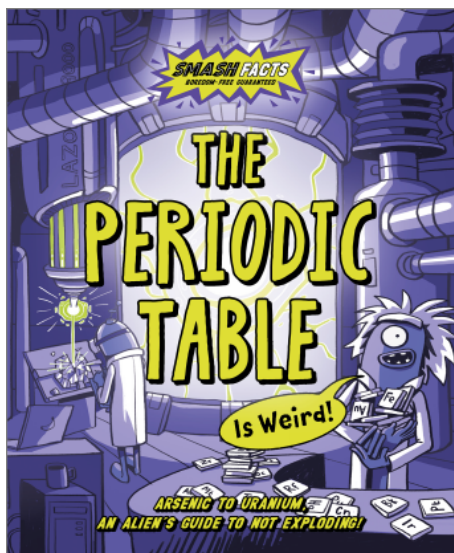
Put them in order: 6 9 16 17 25 30.

$$\text{The range is } 30 - 6 = 24.$$

Transition metals sit in the centre of the periodic table. They are less reactive than the alkali metals, and they tend to be tougher, with higher melting points.

## TITANIUM

Titanium is used in the construction of planes, ships and spacecraft, since it is as strong as steel, but almost half the weight.

Titanium is named after the **Titans**, who were gods from Greek mythology.

OR YOU COULD USE TOOTHPASTE AS PAINT, SUN CREAM AND MAKE-UP...

Most titanium is used to make titanium dioxide, which is a **white pigment** used in paint, sun cream, make-up, paper and toothpaste.

## SCANDIUM

When exposed to the air, scandium becomes **yellow or pink**.

It is used in the manufacture of baseball bats, aircraft parts and high-intensity lights for film and TV production.

Scandium is much more common on the Moon and inside the Sun than it is on Earth.

## VANADIUM

It is **highly resistant** to corrosion (being worn down) and can even withstand the effects of acid!

Vanadium was **discovered twice!** In 1801, a letter announcing its first discovery by Anders Mörner del Rio was lost in a shipwreck; it was rediscovered in 1830 by Swedish chemist Nils Sefström.

Vanadium **stays hard** at very high temperatures, so it is used in circular saws, drill bits, engine turbines and other moving parts that get really hot.

Vanadium is named after Vanadis, the Scandinavian goddess of beauty.

## CHROMIUM

Using a technique called **electroplating**, a thin layer of chromium can be applied to metal and plastic objects, including car parts and household appliances, to give a shiny finish.

Chromium is the **third hardest** element, just behind carbon and boron.

Chromium has a very high melting point of **1,890°C (3,434°F)**.

## IRON

Humans have been using iron to make tools and weapons since ancient times. The first iron found by humans probably came from **meteorites** – pieces of rock or metal that fell to Earth from space.

Its chemical symbol, **Fe**, comes from the **Latin** word for iron, **ferrum**.

Mars' **red colour** is due to the amount of iron oxide, also known as 'rust', on the planet's surface.

Animals and plants need iron. Plants use iron in photosynthesis, and humans need iron to help their **blood** carry oxygen around their bodies.

## MANGANESE

Manganese takes its name from the Latin word **magnes**, meaning **magnet**, even though it isn't magnetic.

There is evidence that manganese was used as a pigment in ancient **cave paintings** and that early humans used it as make-up nearly 50,000 years ago.

It is an essential part of **photosynthesis**. Without manganese, plants would not produce oxygen.

## COBALT

Cobalt is best known for its use in dyes. Cobalt blue, a bright blue pigment, was widely used in antique **Chinese porcelain**.



Cobalt gets its name from the German word **kobalt**, which means **goblin**.

In the 1340s, cobalt was added to beer, so that the beer kept its foam once poured, but it was found to be **unhealthy**.
