


PERSPECTIVE

Perspective means the way you see something. In art it is a way of drawing so the viewer feels almost like they are part of the scene. Pictures with perspective look more 3D.

The key to a picture with perspective is drawing things smaller the further away they are.

Then, mark the **vanishing** point lightly with an X. This is where detail vanishes into the distance.


Use a ruler to draw light guidelines from the corners of your foreground object to the X. Now you have a grid to fit the rest of the drawing into.

Proportion

Start by drawing the

big things at the foreground.

Playing with proportion can also show depth. A person standing straight and still will have certain proportions. But to show that person running towards you, the proportions change: one arm and the opposite leg will be much bigger to show them closer, and the distant foot and hand will be smaller.




PH SCALE

The pH scale measures how acidic or alkaline a liquid is. It runs from 0 to 14, where 0 is a very strong acid and 14 is a very strong alkali. A neutral substance - such as water - measures pH 7.

which are very reactive so the more hydrogen ions in the solution, the stronger the acid. Alkalis contain more hydroxide ions, which are also reactive, so the more

Neutral substances contain roughly the same amount of hydrogen ions as hydroxide ions. These two opposite ions balance each other out and make water. The further from neutral, the more dangerous the substance is.



An easy way to measure pH is with litmus paper. It contains a special **reagent** (something that causes a chemical reaction) and when it is dipped into the liquid being tested it turns a colour on the pH scale. The pH is revealed by matching the litmus paper with the right colour on the pH chart.

Photosynthesis

PHOTOSYNTHESIS

Photosynthesis is the chemical reaction that takes place inside plants to turn sunlight, air and water into food for the plant.





Let there be food

The word photosynthesis means 'to put together with light'. It comes from the Greek 'photo' meaning 'light', and 'synthesis' for 'put together'. Light provides the energy needed to put together the chemicals to create food.

POLYMER


A polymer is a chemical that is made up of many other **molecules** bonded together to make one very large molecule. Often the building block molecules of a polymer are many repeats of the same molecule, repeating in a pattern.

> There are both natural and **synthetic** polymers, but they all tend to be solid, mouldable, strong and hard wearing.



Synthetic polymers are plastics. More than 330 million tons are made





One of many

The word 'polymer' comes from the Greek for 'many parts'. A monomer is a single part. Polythene is made up of many molecules (monomers) of ethene strung together. PVC (polyvinyl chloride) is made from vinyl chloride combined to make rigid or flexible plastic.
