Insects normally have two **antennae** – these are used for sensing their surroundings.

It is impossible to count the number of insects on Earth, but it could be as many as **ten quintillion**.
That's 10,000,000,000,000,000,000.

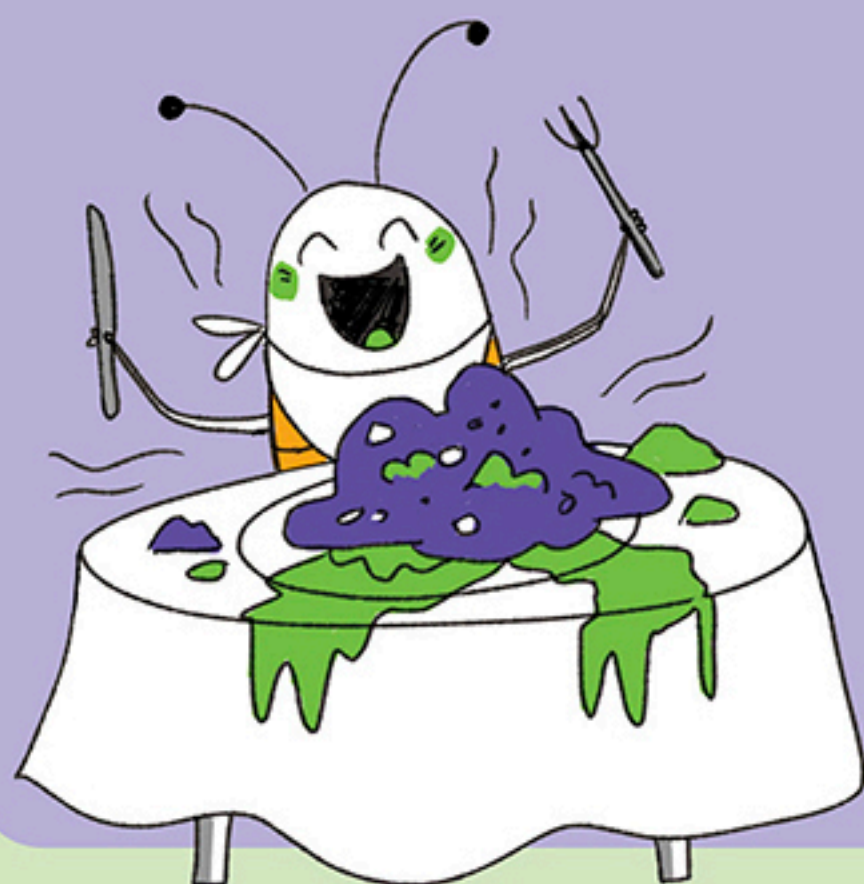


Bugs can be found everywhere, but there is **only one insect** that is native to Antarctica – the *Belgica antarctica*, a tiny midge that can't fly.

Insects eat lots of different things and each species has **evolved** to eat a certain type of food.

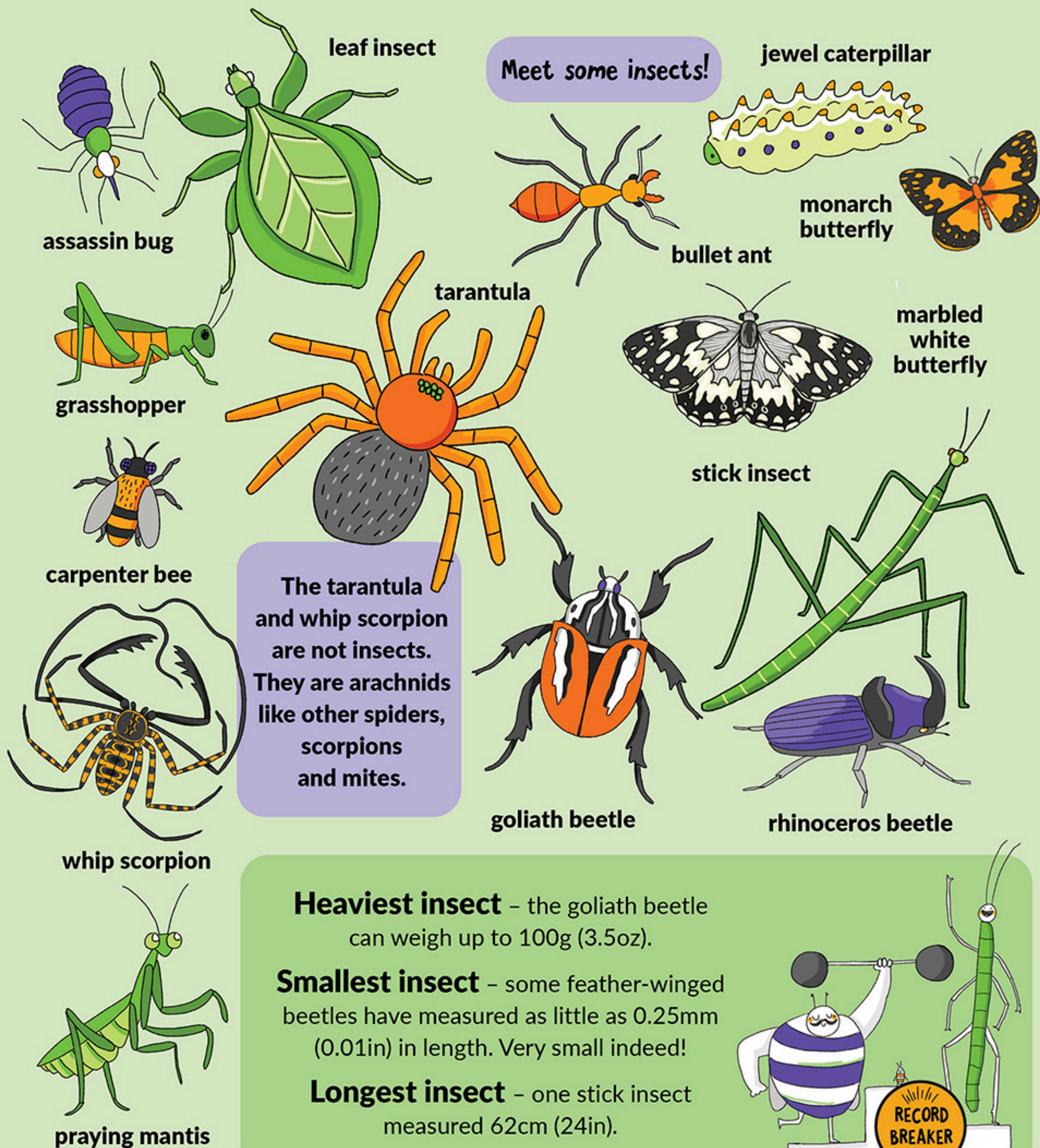

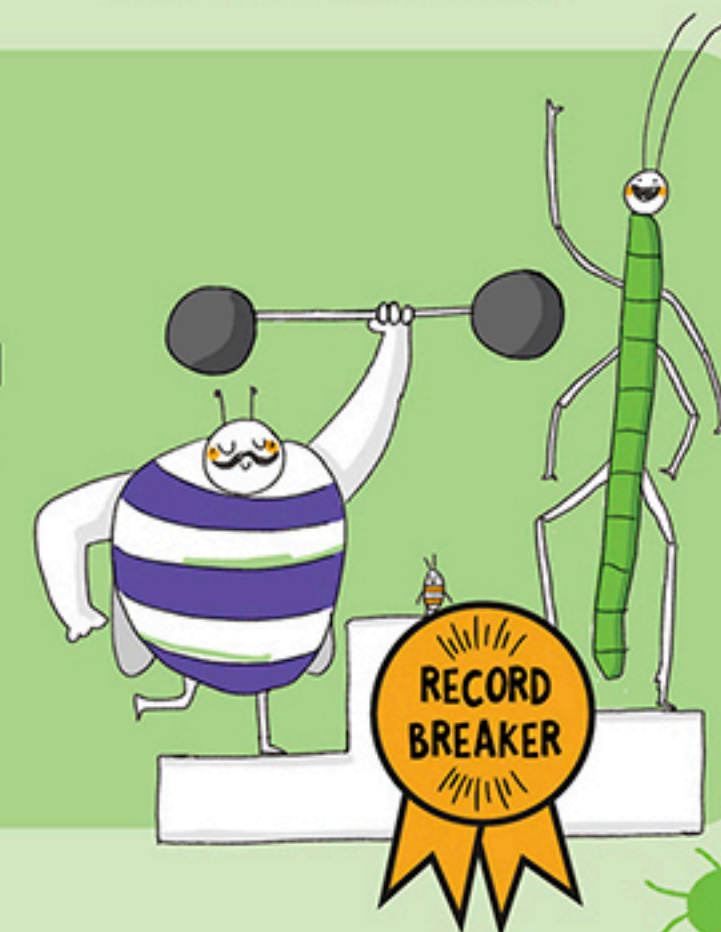


The tarantula and whip scorpion are not insects. They are arachnids like other spiders, scorpions and mites.

Heaviest insect – the goliath beetle can weigh up to 100g (3.5oz).

Smallest insect – some feather-winged beetles have measured as little as 0.25mm (0.01in) in length. Very small indeed!

Longest insect – one stick insect measured 62cm (24in).

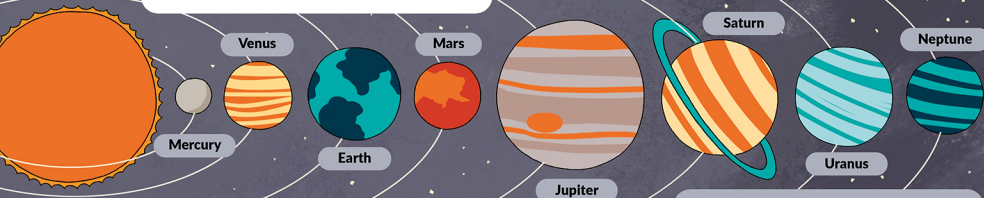

The Solar System

A **planetary system** is a set of objects, such as planets or asteroids, that orbit a star. There are over 2,500 such systems in our galaxy. We call our planetary system – the Sun and the objects that orbit it – the **solar system**.

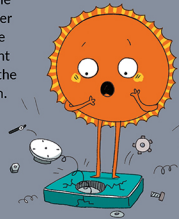
It takes Earth about **365 days** to orbit the Sun. This is our year. Earth makes a full rotation on its axis in **24 hours**. This is our day.



Until 16th century astronomer **Nicolaus Copernicus** showed us that the planets orbit the Sun, people believed that Earth was the centre of the solar system.



The Sun alone makes up over **99%** of the mass (amount of matter) in the solar system.



Beyond the main planets is the **Kuiper belt** – a region full of icy objects, such as Pluto.



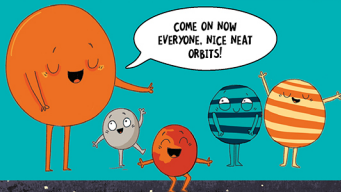
Pluto was considered a planet until 2006.

Interstellar space is the area beyond the edge of the Sun's magnetic field.

Voyager 1 was the first spacecraft to reach interstellar space and it took **35 years** to get there from Earth!

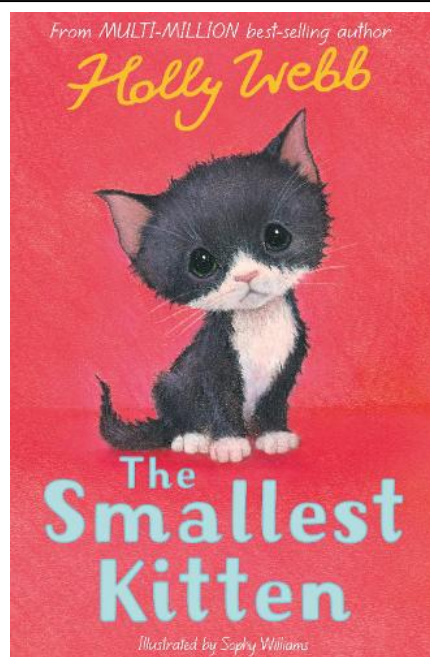


The solar system was formed around **4.5 billion** years ago.



The distance from the Sun to Neptune, the furthest planet, is over **4,500,000,000km** (2,800,000,000mi)!
