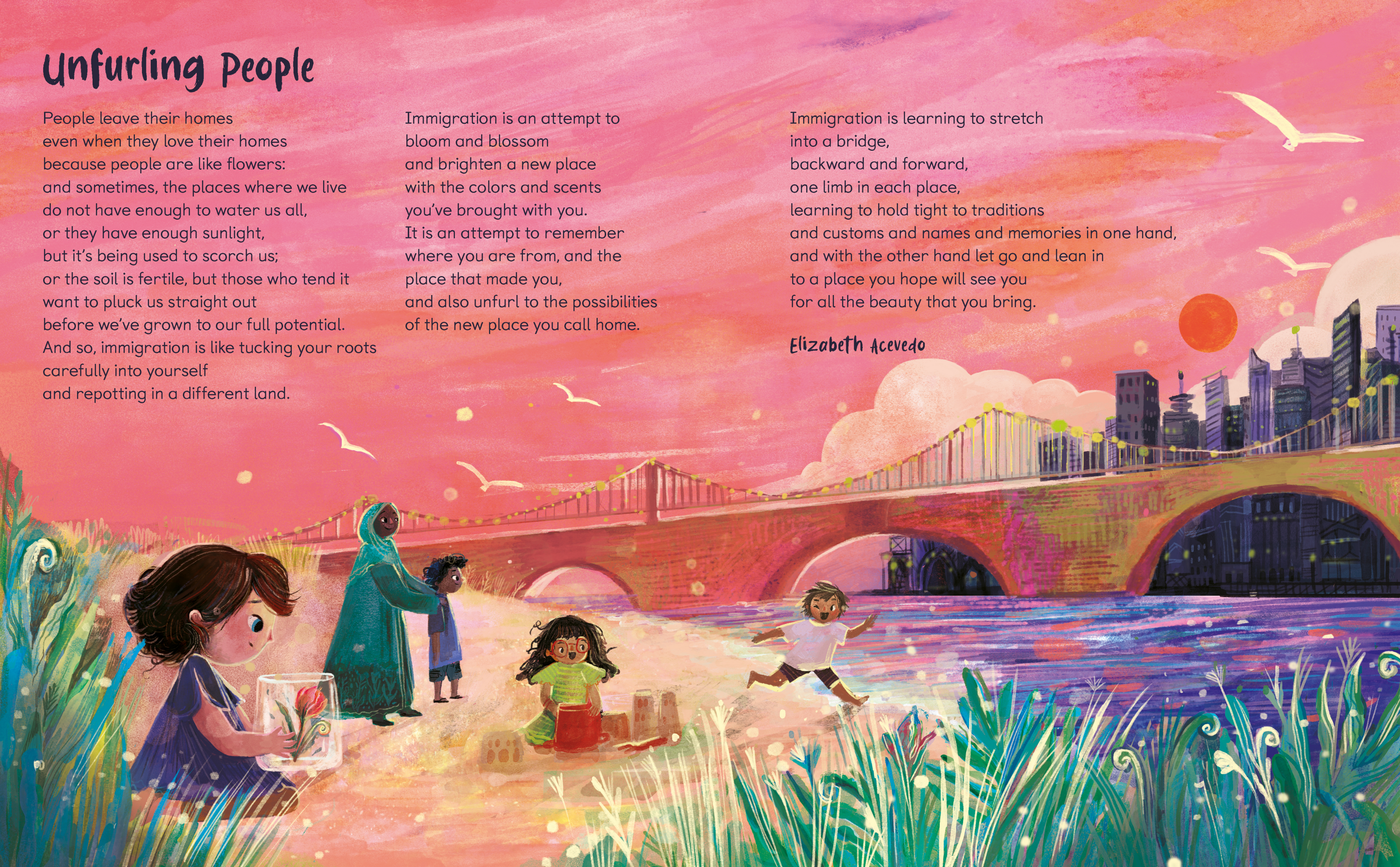
# Unfurling People

and repotting in a different land.

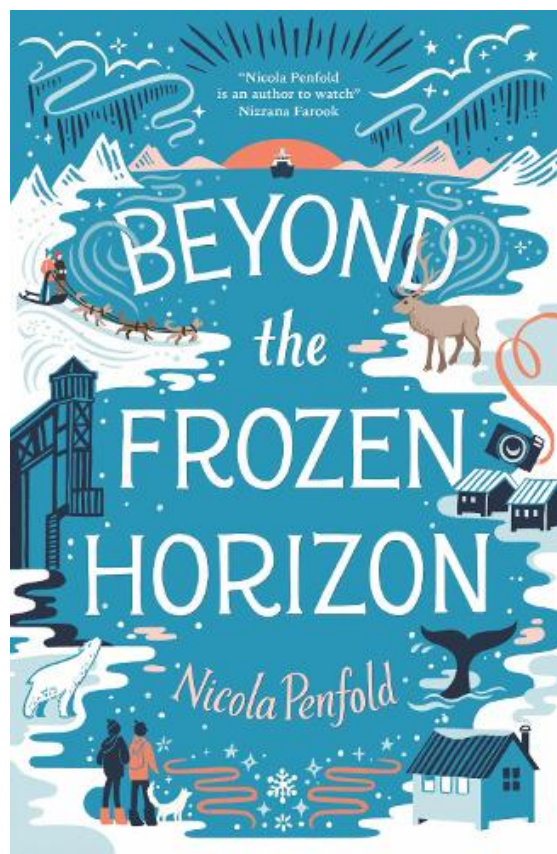
Immigration is an attempt to
