
Get your arm ready for getting noticed and cheering along! Stretch one arm out and punch the air above your head ten times. Repeat with the other arm. Don't go too fast



Lay on the floor and slow your breathing. When you breathe in your belly should rise, and when breathing out it should fall.



MISTAKES OF THE PAST

From Little Red Riding Hood to The Three Little Pigs, tales of howling wolves with huge appetites have taught us to fear these skilled hunters, but as this true story will show, wolves have more to fear


Long before humans arrived, packs of wolves roamed wild in Yellowstone; then, in the 1800s, European settlers moved west bringing cows and sheep with them. They let their livestock graze freely and the wolves enjoyed an easy meal, so fear and hatred of wolves grew. Over the next hundred years, people hunted, trapped, and poisoned the wolves across America, until, in 1926, the last two wolf pups in Yellowstone were killed by park rangers.

With the wolves gone, coyotes moved into their territory and killed large numbers of foxes, and pronghorn. Meanwhile, the elk herds that were normally hunted by wolves grazed undisturbed. They munched through the young plants and willows along the riverside. Without the willows, beavers went without food, shelter, and wood to build their dams. Without beaver dams, the rivers flowed too fast for fish to feed and spawn. Without enough fish to eat, otters and bears went hunary, and so

By the 1960s and 1970s, people realized that the wolves had an important role to play in keeping nature in balance. Many laws were passed to correct the mistakes of the past. In 1975, the long process of deciding how to bring wolves back to Yellowstone began. Eventually, in 1995, the first grey wolves were released back into the park. The wolves thrived and the natural order was restored. Today, the howl of wolves rings out
