Sticky tape


Coloured

1. Copy or trace the shapes below onto your piece of card using your pencil.
2. Make sure to cover the entire page but leave gaps in-between the shapes.
3. With the help of an adult, take the scissors and cut out these shapes so you are left with a stencil shape.
4. Stick pieces of coloured tissue paper over the holes.
5. Bend the paper so that it forms a conical shape like a tube and tape the sides together.
6. Place the tube over a lamp or light bulb with the help of an adult.
7. Now turn off all the other lights and let the shapes and colours dance across your room!





Other artists painted groups of flowers in bouquets and vases but Mondrian was only interested in painting one flower at a time. He wanted to focus on the shape and structure of the flower, so that he could paint it perfectly.




1. Using your wax crayon or candle, draw the petals of your flower on the paper. Make sure to press fairly hard. You won't be able to see what you have drawn until you paint over it in the next step.
2. Dip your paintbrush in the water so it is really wet. Choose a paint colour and using the brush, paint a light wash across the entire piece of paper. Watch as your petals are revealed through the paint!
3. Leave the page to dry, and then with your paintbrush, draw the stem and leaves of the flower. Don't use as much water this time so you get a bolder colour!




Mondrian loved to play with grids. In this artwork below he decided to turn the canvas around to make a diamond shape. The cross section of lines make the painting look like an optical illusion.

What does it look like to you? Does the painting look flat or is there depth? Perhaps the lines appear to move in front of your eyes?



Make your own DIY kaleidoscope!




You will need:



A ruler




A toilet roll tube



1. Measure 10 x 15cm onto the back of your mirrored paper using your pencil and ruler.




3. Make two folds, lengthways along the paper so it has three sections.



2. With the help of an adult carefully cut along these lines so you have a small rectangle.




4. Fold the paper inwards to make a prism shape. Tape the edges together. Make sure the shiny side faces inside.




5. Slot the prism into the toilet roll tube and now you have your kaleidoscope!



6. Hold it up to your eye and look through it at the different patterns in this book. What can you see?


BIOGRAPHY

AUTHOR BIOGRAPHY






