Evolution in action

Every year, for 40 years, Rosemary and Peter Grant went to study finches on the tiny island of Daphne Major. They took their two daughters with them, Thalia and Nicola, from when they were 6 and 8 years old. The girls made friends with a sea lion cub, played violin for the blue-footed boobies and helped with the scientific studies. Over the years, the Grants saw the finches' beaks changing. The birds were beginning to evolve into new species.

- Daphne Major -

Size: <0.5 sqkm Highest point: 120 m Human population: 0 (4 when the Grant family was there)

After a bad drought in 1977 only big seeds were available. Only finches with big beaks were able to eat these seeds. The next generations inherited bigger beaks from those surviving birds. Gradually, the finches' beaks got bigger.

> In 1982 El Niño struck. It poured with rain, vines grew all over Daphne Major and there were loads of fruit and seeds. This time, the surviving finches were the ones with smaller beaks that are better for eating smaller, softer seeds. After El Niño, the finches' beaks got smaller.



The Grants saw evolution happening right before their eyes, much faster than anyone expected – not over millions of years but within just a few years and a few generations of birds. Charles Darwin would have been totally amazed!

Navjot Sawhney is the founder of The Washing Machine Project, which designs, manufactures and distributes low-cost manual washing machines. These human-powered machines save time, water and effort for the millions of people, usually women, who have no choice but to handwash clothes for themselves and their families.

WHY DID YOU BECOME AN ENGINEER?

My parents fled India in the 1940s to escape the war that was happening there. They moved to the UK in the 1980s, and I was born in London. From an early age, I learnt of the harrowing experiences that my parents had suffered and became familiar with the concepts of loss, displacement and hard work.

"I wanted to use my engineering skills to help the disadvantaged rather than just create things for people who already had so much."

My father was an aerospace engineer and would often take me to air shows. I was fascinated with how massive machines could stay in the sky. Full of curiosity, I would raid my father's toolbox to take apart every home appliance, not really knowing how to put them back together again.

My father passed away when I was eight years old, so I grew up amongst the women of my family: my mum, her five sisters and my two older sisters. I truly appreciated their role in our household as I saw how much work they did and the trouble they went through just to allow us all to get by in life.

I went to university to study Aerospace Engineering where I learnt to design and build spacecraft.

After graduating, I got a fantastic job at Dyson, one of the world's leading technology companies.

I was in the Research and Innovation Team, and it was an awesome experience, but something was missing.

I needed a change of direction, so I applied to Engineers Without Borders for an 18-month placement in rural southern India. Engineers Without Borders started in the early 1980s to allow engineers to share their time and skills with local people. The organisation has helped to improve

Space exploration is a fast-paced industry and, recently, huge leaps in space technology have been driven by a number of private companies, such as SpaceX, Blue Origin and Virgin Galactic. Previously, most space exploration was funded by governments. These companies have developed reusable rockets and launching components that can be assembled in space with the aim to make space travel more accessible and sustainable. The vision of humans living on other planets might not be as far away as we imagine!

International Space Station (ISS) has been orbiting at around 408 kilometres above Earth. From Earth, the ISS looks like a star, but up close you can see that it's a feat of human engineering! Made up of different modules and powered by eight giant solar panels, the ISS is the largest orbiting laboratory ever built. Such a huge object couldn't be transported to space in one piece, so it was taken in bits and assembled there. The ISS is a brilliant example of how vehicles can not only be built in space but also upgraded and maintained there, paving the way for the possibility of other human habitats in space.



There are usually between three and seven crew members living and working aboard the ISS at all times, conducting experiments and ensuring everything is functioning correctly. or services produced in space for use on Earth are called Space-for-Earth technologies. Some huge parts of this are our telecommunications, navigation and observation satellites. However, the combination of zero gravity, a sterile environment and the availability of solar power means space has the ideal conditions for producing other things, such as vaccines, foods and supplements that can be easily created in a variety of conditions.



In the future, it might be possible to mine asteroids for useful resources.

MINING ASTEROIDS Of the thousands of asteroids in our solar system, many are known to contain important elements, including the precious metals platinum, iron and nickel. These are used in the production of everything from phones to cars, but there is only a limited supply here on Earth. This has led to the idea that asteroids could be mined so that the elements can be used either on Earth or in space. Any water mined from asteroids could also be used to support human life in space.

humans first ventured into space, we've been leaving debris behind – everything from old satellites and parts of rockets to nuts and bolts. With more spacecraft leaving our atmosphere, it is becoming increasingly important to clear up this junk and avoid it causing a dangerous collision. Scientists and engineers are working on a range of solutions, and in 2021 launched a satellite that uses magnets to collect space junk. Another satellite with a giant litter-picking claw is currently in development.
