Did you know?

- Cricket is thought to have started as a way for English shepherds to pass the time whilst looking after sheep, who were the first fielders and probably no worse at it than your little brother.
- Although it started in 16th Century in England, a game in Aleppo in Syria was written about in 1676! And the first ever international was played between the US and Canada in New York in 1844.
- Test cricket is one of the longest games in the world (normally 5 days). The longest match ever was between England and South Africa – it went on for 2 weeks!
- It is estimated that there are nearly 60 million players of cricket in the world with over 2 billion fans, which makes it the second most popular sport in the world after football. It is played in over 100 countries.

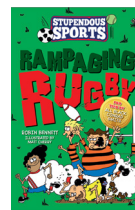

Mary Anning

1799 - 1847, UK

Pioneering fossil explorer



Many of Mary's discoveries, including this magnificent Plesiosaur, can be seen today in the Natural History Museum in London.

In 2010, almost 200 years after her death, Mary was listed by The Royal Society as one of the top ten women to influence the development of science.



Mary Anning's story

I was born in Lyme Regis on the Dorset coast. My father was a poor cabinet-maker who also sold fossils collected from the seashore to make extra money, and I helped him. When my father died in 1810, my mother encouraged me to continue fossil hunting, to help put food on the table...

In 1811 my brother discovered something very exciting – a huge fossil skull embedded in the cliff. It was a great discovery, yet I felt there was more to come. I searched for weeks and at last found the rest of its skeleton. At first the fossil was thought to be an ancient crocodile. But when I found a complete specimen that was over 19 feet (6 metres) long, scientists realised this was a new sort of prehistoric sea reptile. They named it *Ichthyosaurus*. Then, in 1823, I found a huge fossil creature with such a long neck that at first some experts thought I had made a fake. Scientists named this one *Plesiosaurus*.

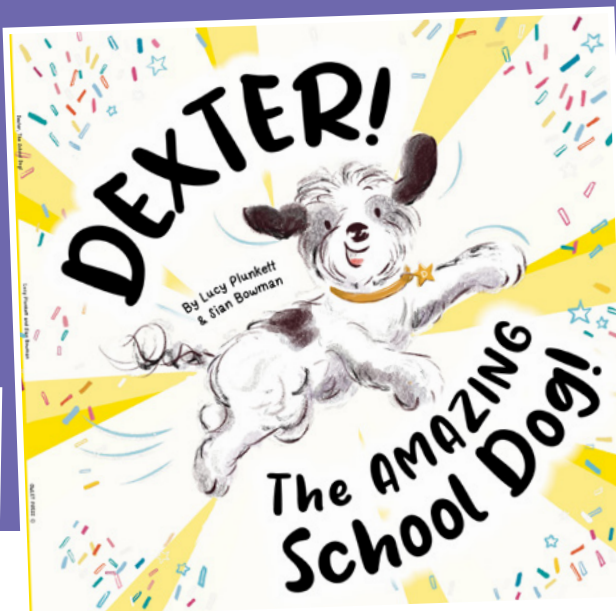
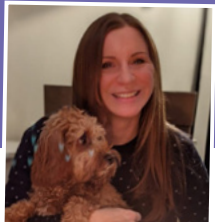
By now scientists were travelling from as far as New York to come fossil-hunting with me. In 1828 I discovered the tangled bones of what turned out to be a flying reptile, a *Pterosaur*, that caused a public sensation when it was displayed in London.

Despite finding hundreds of fossils, studying anatomy and carefully drawing my finds in letters to my scientific customers, I was rarely even mentioned in those men's essays and lectures. The Geological Society, to which they belonged, refused even to allow me to attend their lectures on my fossil finds!



From six years old, Mary was her father's fossil-collecting assistant. Fossils are prehistoric creatures or plants whose remains became buried in mud, sand or silt. Over millions of years this becomes rock.

Mary went on to dodge high tides and survive cliff landslides, searching on her own or with her friend Elizabeth Philpott, to bring the world her discoveries. Yet she was never given the credit she deserved in her lifetime.

IN FULL FEATHER

We now know that modern birds are descended from theropods, the same group of dinosaurs as *T. rex*. So it makes sense to think that *T. rex* might also have had feathers.

Soft parts of animals, like skin and feathers, do not fossilise as easily as hard parts, like teeth and bones. So, we currently have very little fossil evidence to tell us what dinosaurs' skin looked like and there is no direct proof showing that *T. rex* had feathers. However, fossils of other tyrannosaurs, including *Yutyrannus* and *Dilong* found in China, show that they had feathered coats. So, it's reasonable to think that *T. rex* may also have been feathered, although tyrannosaur feathers would probably have been shaggier and simpler than birds' flight feathers.

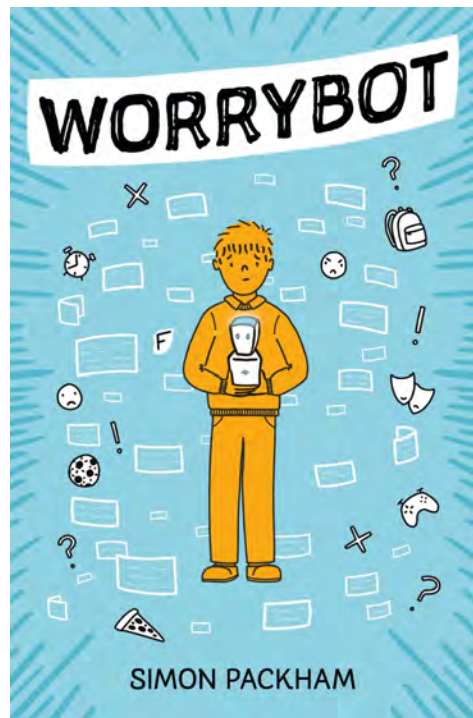
THE GREATER-CRESTED TYRANNOSAUR

Experts are not sure how much of *T. rex*'s body was covered in feathers. The few fossils of adult *T. rex* skin that have been found have a scaly texture, but other parts of its body may have been feathered. Or it may have had feathers on top of the scales.

Although most modern reptiles are cold-blooded, theropods such as *T. rex* were warm-blooded, like modern birds.

It's easier for a large warm-blooded animal to keep warm than a small animal. This is why elephants don't have fur, while mice living in the same climate do. So, while a young *T. rex* might have been covered in downy feathers, like a young bird, an adult would not have needed as many.
