But... I heard that UFOs are knocking down wind turbines. Shouldn't we be worried about flying saucer crashes?


People really have said this. In 2009, workers found a blade broken off a turbine in Lincolnshire. The whole machine was wrecked. Bright lights were seen in the sky the night before. Adding two and two together and getting 1,000, some people decided a low-flying UFO had run into the windmill. Wind turbine experts poured cold water on this theory, explaining that it was a normal accident due to ordinary wear and tear. Remind your grown-ups: any aliens who can steer between the planets are probably smart enough to avoid a single windmill.

Today, more than 5 per cent of the world's electricity comes from wind power, and that percentage will probably grow quickly.

Heat from the Sun, our never-failing source of energy, drives winds that turn windmill blades. We can also use that sunlight directly to power our houses and businesses. Solar power is one of the best known and cheapest forms of renewable energy.

In 1954, scientists focused light on a little panel of silicon (a common element in Earth's crust), and in turn that panel spun a toy Ferris wheel. This was the first practical solar cell. Since then, solar cells have given clean energy to everything from the International Space Station to farms in Australia.
