Richard Long is a land artist whose work in nature has influenced Goldsworthy and many others.



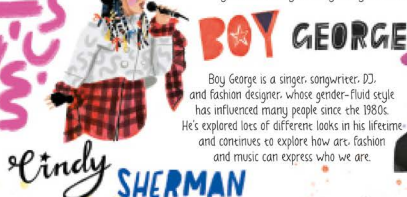
SAM VAN AKEN

We might not know if we're looking at a sculpture or a stadium, but figuring it out is the fun part!

Antoni Gaudi was a Spanish architect whose style was unlike anything that had come before. His work was inspired by patterns he found in nature and his buildings were so unusual that no-one could find the words to describe them. People still flock to see these incredible buildings today even though one of them is still under construction, nearly 140 years after it was started!

Frank Lloyd Wright is often considered to be a founder of modern architecture. He changed people's ideas about how buildings are designed and used.



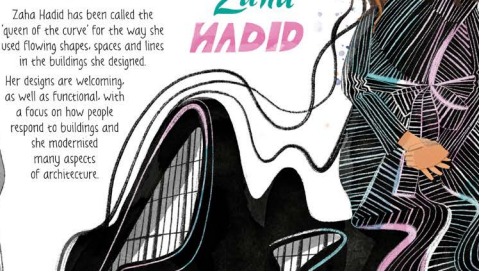

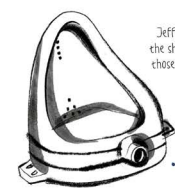

Marcel Duchamp's 'Fountain' sculpture was actually a urinal that he put on display! Lots of people thought that was surreal - it definitely made them all stop and think!

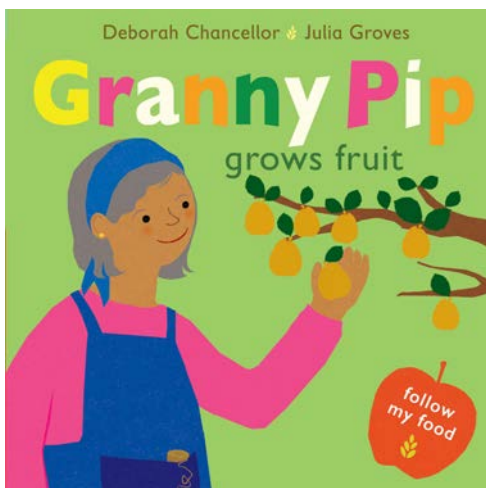
