ewel bugs are true bugs in the family Scutelleridae. They lay their eggs in clusters on plants. After the embryos inside the eggs mature, they wiggle around until eventually they push their way out through the top of the egg. They emerge as nymphs, and then often remain together in their cluster, spending much of their time feeding on plants. Some experts believe that this clustering behavior makes the group look larger—and more intimidating to predators.

Jewel bugs typically have bright iridescent colors, such as green, red, purple, pink, and blue. Their iridescence is not caused by pigments, but by how light interacts with the surface of their bodies.

The shiny creatures shown here are just some of the amazing jewel bugs found around the world. Check them out!


