




THAT DAY








So, how come there are immortal jellyfish?

Yep, that's right—there are immortal jellyfish! How cool is that! I was writing about the impossibility of human immortality. Meanwhile, this animal can theoretically live forever, until the end of time. A genuine superhero!

It won't surprise you that this medusa is one of my favourite jellyfish species (Tll tell you about my other favourites later). It is one of the most exciting animals on our planet because the immortality thing is something no one else has worked out. Some say that sea anemones can live forever, but the Turritopsis dohrnii (which is the scientific name of the immortal jellyfish) is clearly the brightest star in the "immortality heavener"

Since this jellyfish species was discovered, scientists have meticulously studied the animal to discover its secrets. This medusa is really tiny, just three to five millimetres in size. It was first discovered in the Mediterranean Sea but has now been found in practically every ocean and seems to thrive in all of them.



It's King Winter's birthday, and he wants it to be really special. He wants all of his brothers and sisters to be there: King Summer, Queen Spring and Queen Autumn.


