I practically skip towards it, down the path where the trees grow dense in a circle.

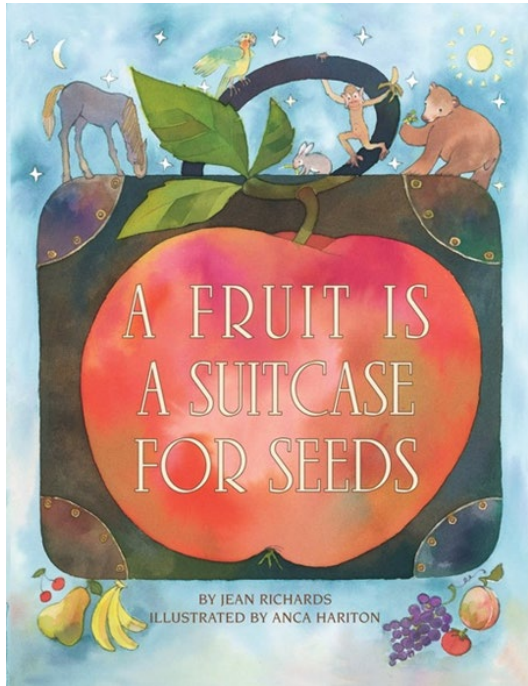

Diana Alexandra Pazmiño Jaramillo, a shark scientist from the University of San Francisco de Quito, Ecuador, focuses on shark forensics – detective work on the bodies of sharks taken from foreign fishing

boats that shows whether they were caught legally or not. Her clue-checking process involves DNA and can be used to enforce shark fishing rules in other parts of the world, protecting endangered sharks.

catch sharks when seeking other fish. The Galápagos Islands are one of the few sites in the world where shark populations are healthy. Pelayo Salinas de León, a marine ecologist at the Charles Darwin Foundation, found that the islands Darwin and Wolf are home to the world's largest biomass of sharks, which means the most sharks in an area its size anywhere in the world. So, shark scientists working here have a unique study opportunity.

There are so many sharks partly because the reserve protects them, but also partly because tourists come here to dive with sharks, making them more valuable alive than dead. Each live shark is worth £300,000 a year to the local economy, according to Pelayo, so no local tries to kill them.

In May 2020, the organisation Mission Blue announced a new Hope Spot – an underwater animal highway called the Cocos-Galápagos Swimway. They hoped it would become an international marine reserve linking the Galápagos with the coast of Costa Rica. A year later, the MigraMar expedition, a group of scientists from six countries, followed the 2,930-kilometre migratory path themselves. They observed whales, sharks, sea turtles and other migrators. What for? To help increase understanding of the importance of this part of the ocean – and to provide information to leaders with the power to protect the East Pacific.

Potholes at the edge of the sea are often edged by dainty, brightly coloured crabs on tiptoe. Their reflections are mirrored in the water: red legs, orange-gold-rose backs, with dashes of bright blue. These are **Sally Lightfoot crabs**, so called because they can scoot across the surface of the water without sinking. Like most animals on these islands, they aren't scared of people unless they think you're about to step on them.

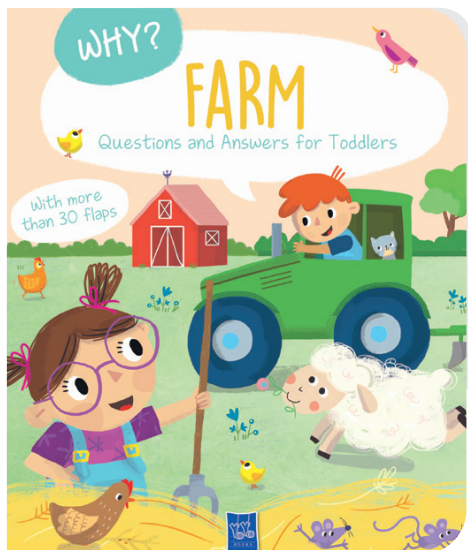

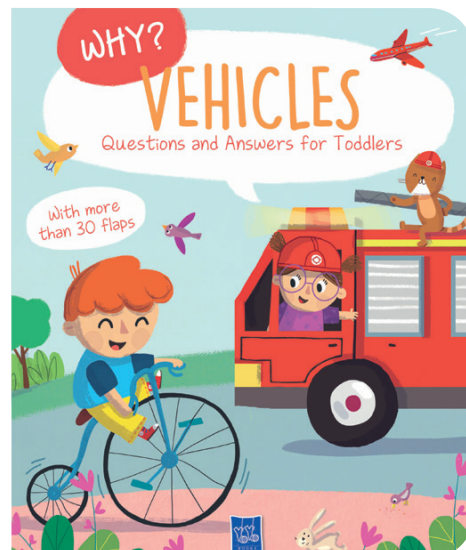

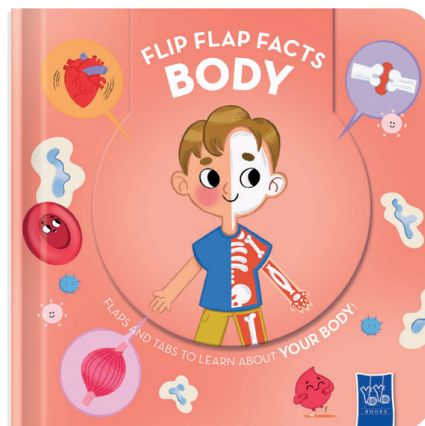
