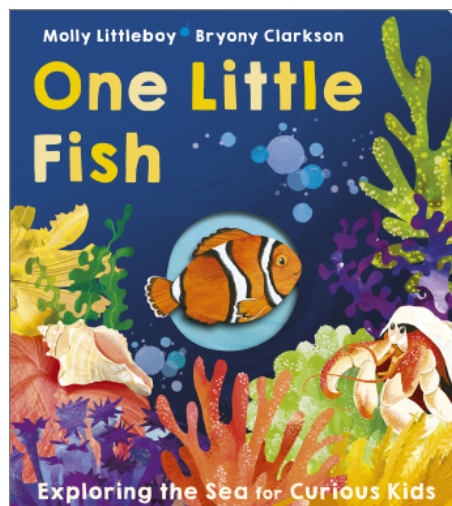
About the Illustrator
