AN ISLAND PLUCKED BARE

Laysan, a small island in the Hawaiian archipelago, was once home to a large number of rare and beautiful birds, including black-footed albatrosses, great frigatebirds, red-tailed tropicbirds and masked boobies. More than 10 million birds inhabited this area of just 4 square kilometres.

What they wanted was the birds' droppings (known as 'guano'), which they could trade as a **fertiliser**. The hunters also harvested feathers as these had become a fashion accessory in major Western cities in the 20th century.

But in the early 20th century, the birds of Laysan suffered a terrible fate. Hunters from the United States, France, Britain and Japan arrived in large numbers to kill them. In the space of two years, 300,000 birds were slaughtered. Unlike in New Zealand and Mauritius, these hunters didn't want to eat the birds.

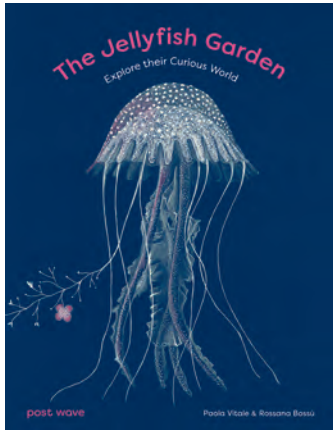
BIRD BULLETIN:

The island of Laysan was home to so many birds that the Hawaiians called it 'Kau', meaning 'egg'. Today, the island still lives up to its name. Thanks to conservation measures, its large bird population has been restored.

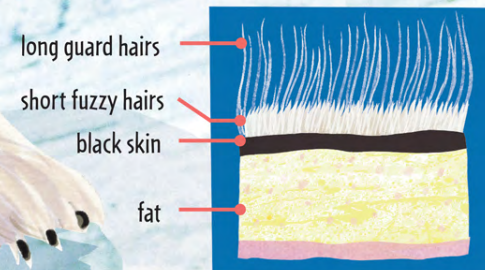
Polar bears occasionally overheat! They cool down by rolling in the snow or by jumping in the sea.

Polar bear fur may look white, but each hair is actually transparent.

Tuffy fur keeps their toes toasty.

How do polar bears keep warm?

Not many creatures can survive the freezing temperatures of the Arctic – but polar bears can! A polar bear has a thick layer of blubbery fat under its skin that stops heat from escaping. The surface of its skin is black, and this dark colouring helps the skin absorb sunshine. Then on top of its skin are two layers of fur: a short, warm, fuzzy layer, and a longer waxy layer on top which keeps water out and warmth in. How cool is that?



Long, thick guard hairs protect the bear's soft undercoat. It's rather like you or me wearing a raincoat over a warm, fleecy jumper.

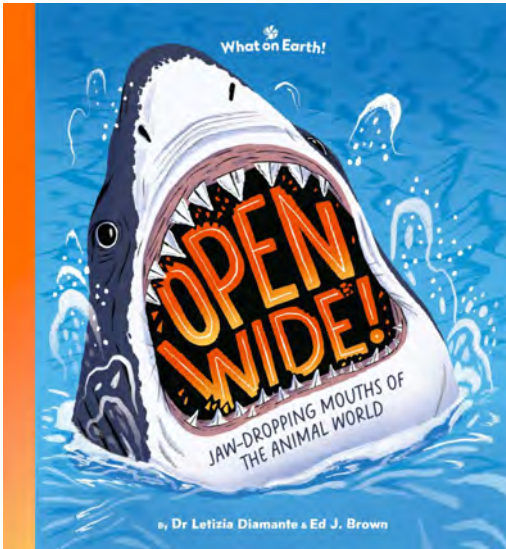

A GREY NURSE SHARK



A shark's teeth are not anchored to bony jaws like ours are, so when a tooth is damaged, another can flip forwards into its place.

The teeth of some sharks are covered with fluoride. This is the same mineral that is used in toothpaste, which helps prevent cavities.

FOSSIL ADVENTURE

All dinosaurs had several sets of teeth that they could replace throughout their lives. When a dinosaur lost a tooth, it would sometimes become preserved as a fossil. Dinosaur teeth can tell us a lot about their owners: what species they belonged to; what type of food they ate and whether they chewed or crushed it, or just swallowed their food whole.

The grin of a *T. rex* must have been quite intimidating! Scientists think that this dinosaur had the strongest bite force of any land animal that has ever lived. A *T. rex*'s 60 sharp, banana-sized teeth seem like they were built for taking down live prey. But experts are still debating whether *T. rex* was both a hunter and a scavenger.



SPOT THE DIFFERENCE TOOTH vs CLAW

T. rex's teeth and claws look quite similar. They are both curved with a point on the end. But look closely and you can see the difference. The tooth has serrated edges, like a bread knife, and it is covered in enamel, which makes it more shiny.

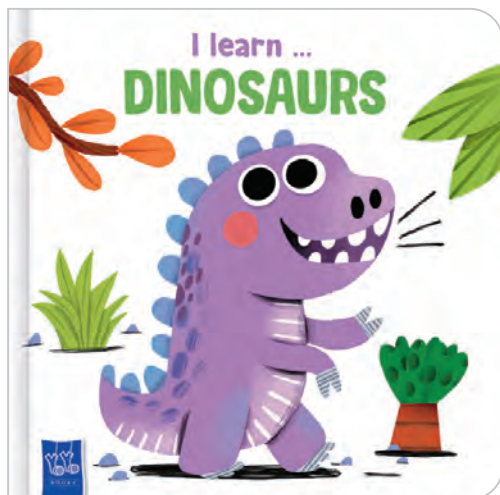

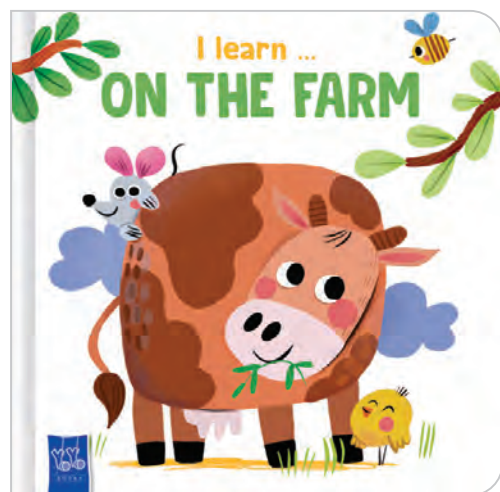
