or most of human history, people thought Earth was all there was. Then we realized the moon and sun were not just lights in the sky, but other objects in space. In time, we found that we were in a solar system of many planets all spinning together. Then, we learned that there are other solar systems outside ours, too: about 4,000 have been confirmed in just our Milky Way galaxy alone. And there could be as many as two trillion galaxies! With so many places that could host living things, most experts think it's extremely likely we are not alone in the universe. Here are four potential signs of life JWST is on the lookout for.

# BREATHE IN When planet Earth was young-

before the first living things formed in our oceans—its skies were filled mostly with carbon dioxide. But then, the first bacteria and other tiny organisms emerged. They breathed in carbon dioxide and breathed out oxygen. Over millions of years, this transformed Earth's atmosphere into something that insects, birds, and mammals—including humans—could breathe. Detecting oxygen in an exoplanet's skies would be a big hint that something could be living there.

## **GAS OUT**


On Earth, phosphine is not a pleasant chemical. It's toxic, explosive, and smells like garlic and rotting fish. It is common on gas giant planets such as Jupiter. But it's also produced on Earth by tiny organisms, including those that live in the guts of animals. That means that its presence on a rocky, Earthlike planet would signal that some kind of life could make its home there. Scientists will also be looking for ammonia, another foul-smelling gas produced by animals on Earth.



# Here on our home planet, methane gas is one of the major drivers of

gas is one of the major drivers of climate change. And one of the largest sources of methane on Earth might surprise you: it's cow burps and farts! That's why finding methane on another planet would be super exciting for alien-hunting astronomers—especially if they detect it together with carbon dioxide, which is produced on Earth when animals breathe out.




# OFF-KILTER ATMOSPHERE

But what if life on another planet looks nothing like life on Earth? What if it doesn't breathe in oxygen and breathe out carbon dioxide or phosphine? Scientists would have no idea what molecules to look for. But they do know to look for something else: An unstable atmosphere. While the skies of lifeless planets like dusty Mars never change, Earth's atmosphere is constantly changing as living things guzzle some chemicals and expel others. An unstable atmosphere would be a clue that a faraway planet might be home to alien creatures.

Marc was born in 1972 with cerebral palsy. When he was very young he used a walking frame to get around but mostly crawled for the first 10 years of his life. Crawling through the house and garden, Marc had a very unique perspective on nature and the world around him and his many adventures helped shape his imagination.

His greatest influences however were the books his dad read to him from the age of 6-9, such as The Wind in the Willows, The Hobbit and The Lord of the Rings, and as he grew up the films of Walt Disney and later Steven Spielberg were also very important to him. In 1991 Marc gained a place at Oxford University to read Modern History, where, by his own admission, he spent far too much time on the river 'messing about in boats', reading and writing stories. Since then he has been in a powered wheelchair all his life, but rather than seeing it has a form of limitation he has always seen it has a vehicle of liberation. It's just a pity that real wheelchairs have so few gadgets, he always says, because, as in his stories, with just a little burst of imagination they could (and should) be as cool as Chitty-Chitty Bang Bang (or James Bond's Aston Martin). He has always written for pleasure and has had, in his words, the most unexpected and biggest adventure of all, that of marriage and raising a family of his own.

Don't get too close! This huge lion's mane jellyfish has up to 1,200 long, trailing tentacles. These give a nasty sting, enough to stun fish and other prey. The jellyfish is so dangerous that small fish sometimes huddle around its body to hide from other predators.
