
Fusion is very common out in space – it is the process by which the Sun, and all other stars, get their energy. Engineers have been working on ways to capture and use the energy from fusion on Earth for decades. It's a huge challenge to replicate the conditions of the Sun on Earth. Katriya Sabin is working on a new way to harness fusion energy that avoids the difficulties others have faced.

### IN FUSION ENERGY?

As a child I spent a lot of time thinking and creating. I was fascinated by the Large Hadron Collider (LHC) at CERN (see page 201 for a career where these subjects more information) on the Swiss-French border. I remember when it was about to be switched on and it felt like the world was waiting to see what would happen. In primary school I joined an after-school science club, run by a very kind and enthusiastic retired engineer. I learnt to solder, which is where you join two things together using molten metal. This seemingly simple engineering process blew my mind, especially after learning that the LHC had temporarily stopped because
