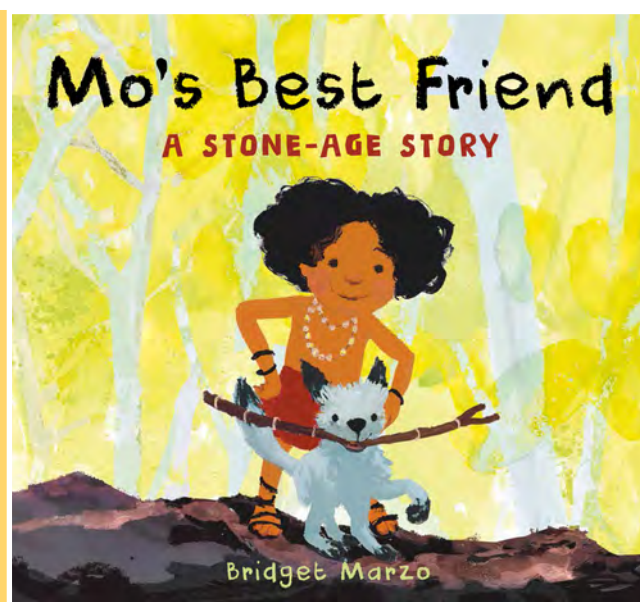
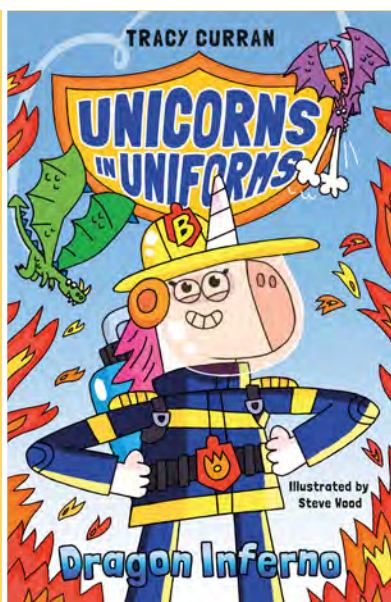

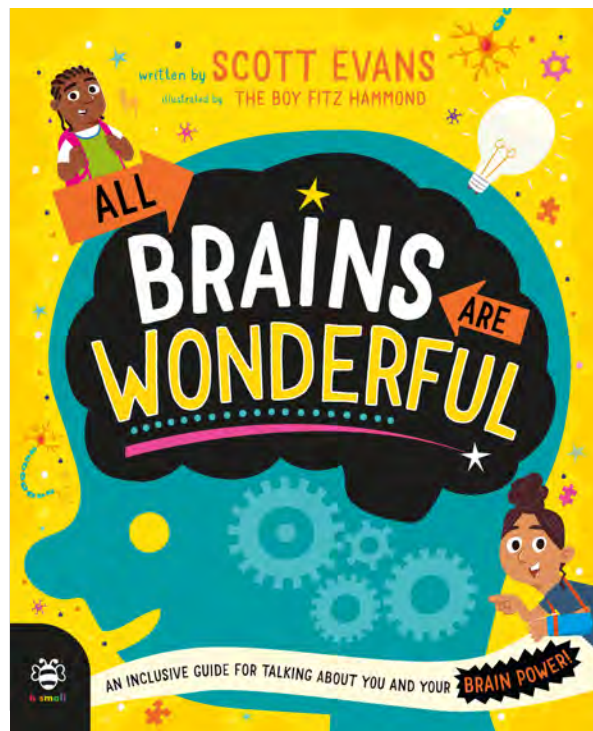

Your brain is *incredible*. It works non-stop to keep you breathing, moving, thinking, feeling, learning and so much more.

And the best part? It's unique to you, making it a V.I.B – a Very Individual Brain!

However, humans aren't the only ones with brains. Other animals have them too, in all shapes and sizes.

The award for the biggest brain goes to ...

... the sperm whale, while larval sea squirts hold the record for the smallest.

Yay!
(I think!)

A larval sea squirt's brain has only 300 cells, compared with the tens of billions of cells that make up a human brain.

Brain-body mass ratio tells us how big an animal's brain is in comparison to its body.



The sperm whale has a **1:5100** ratio, which means their brains are big but their bodies are massive!



Humans have a **1:40** brain-body mass ratio.



Small ants have a **1:7** ratio. Big brains for their tiny bodies!

But brace yourself to meet the bony-eared assfish (yes, that's its real name), whose brain is less than 0.1% of its weight.



Having a bigger brain doesn't always mean being smarter, though. And some animals, such as jellyfish and starfish, don't have a brain at all! Neither do trees and plants, but they have parts that behave like brains to help control how they grow, take in water and respond to light.



But enough about them – let's focus on you! Curious about your brain before you were born? Get ready for some brain-boggling secrets...

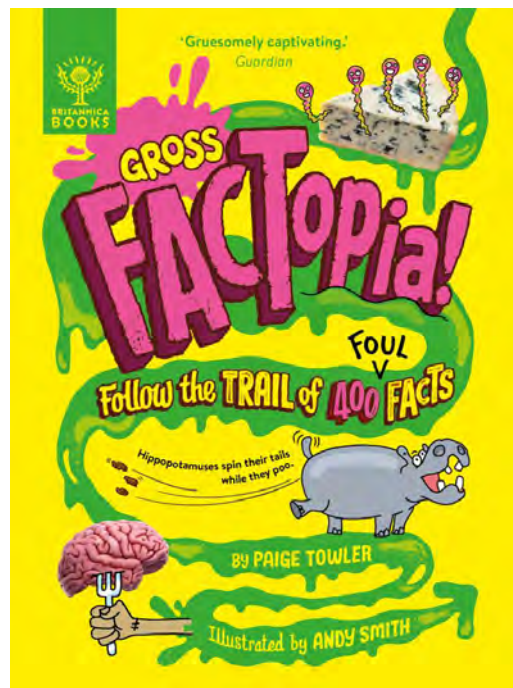

CHOOSING A STRUCTURE



EXAMPLES:

BEAM BRIDGE

DONGHAI

This is the most common, simplest and oldest bridge structure. The basic deck on a beam bridge is supported at each end by an abutment. It is suitable for bridging shorter distances, although modern materials today allow for greater spans.

CHEAPEST SOLUTION

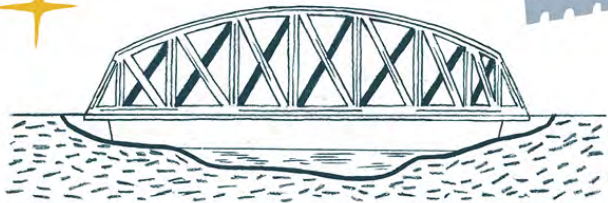


TRUSS BRIDGE

QUEBEC

A strong, resilient structure that comes in various shapes and sizes. Truss bridges are made up of interconnected triangles, creating a sturdy framework that can bear heavy loads.

LIGHTWEIGHT STRUCTURE

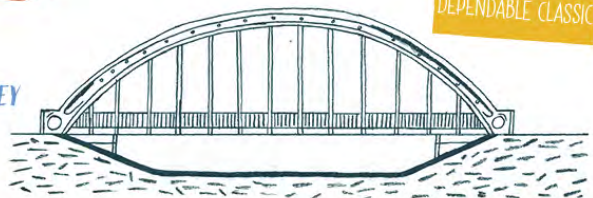
This widespread, attractive, resilient and complex structure comprises one or a succession of arches. Its shape is determined by whether the arch is above, below or in the middle of the bridge's deck. It is suitable for both short and long bridges.

This structure is particularly useful for long distances. The weight of the deck is borne by two main suspension cables, each anchored to a bank by a tower. Steel ropes to hold the deck are lowered from support cables. It is suitable for overcoming wide obstacles and wherever space for support pillars is limited.

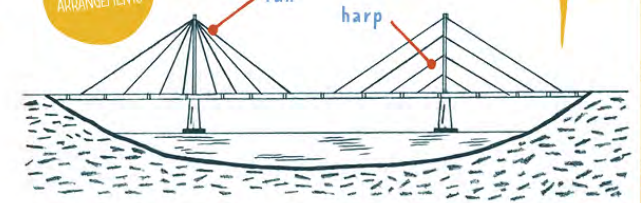

This newest, but most widespread bridge style, has at least one pylon from which the ropes carrying the deck are routed. The arrangement of supporting ropes varies. It is suitable for long and short spans.

This is a reliable and simple design that uses a system of beams, called brackets, that project out horizontally across a space. Usually made up of three parts, the two outermost parts are anchored into the bank, which then carry the middle part of the bridge that is 'balanced' between them.

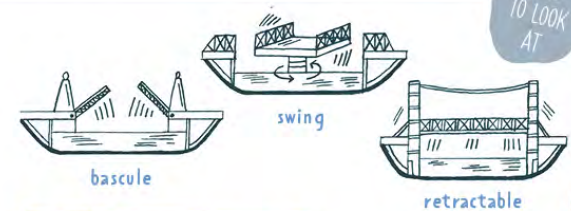

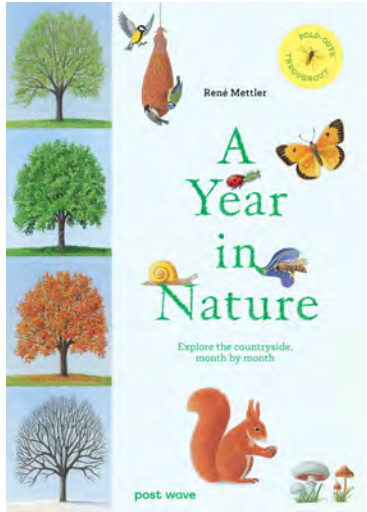

1. Some crows provide an excellent opportunity to observe several crows. A crow is not the only way to identify crows. In fact, crows can be found in many places.

SEA OTTERS

You otter know that these sea-dwelling mammals are more than just cute, they're also a little bizarre. GIRAFFE NECKED WEEVIL

It's no wonder this insect reminds people of the world's most famous long-necked mammal. The male weevil's neck is usually two to three times longer than a female's, and males use it to fight with each other in hopes of impressing a mate. Not to be out-weirded by the males, female weevils do something strange with their eggs. While in a tree, they lay each egg inside a rolled tube of leaf, allowing the egg to then fall safely to the ground. After hatching out, the newborn weevil noshes on the leaf as it grows.
