Emperor penguin chick

Aptenodytes forsteri

- The female emperor penguin lays one egg in May or June, which is winter in Antarctica. The male penguin carefully balances the egg on his feet to keep it off the freezing ice. All through winter storms, he keeps it warm by holding it against a patch of bare skin on his belly.
- After laying her egg, the mother penguin goes out to sea for two months in search of food. By the time the egg hatches, she has usually returned with a belly full of food. She regurgitates, or coughs up, part-digested food to feed to the chick.
- If the chick hatches before the mother returns from her feeding trip, the father feeds the chick himself. He produces a rich milky liquid from a pouch called a crop in his gullet, or food pipe.







- Eohippus is one of the earliest ancestors of the horse—and the donkey and zebra, too.
- It was much smaller than its living relatives, about the same size as a dog.
- Eohippus lived in dense forest, eating leaves and fruits that grew on shrubs.
- It was not a fast runner like a horse, but being small it could easily dash out of sight if danger approached.
- A horse's foot has a hoof, but *Eohippus*'s feet were different; they had four toes on the front feet and three at the back.

- Eohippus's descendants evolved into horses because the world became drier and the forests turned to open grasslands, where it was safer to be a large, fast runner.
- Some experts suggest that *Eohippus* was also the ancestor of the rhinoceros.



- This woodblock print is the most famous and widely reproduced work in Japanese art. It was made by an artist called Hokusai.
- The print is one of a series of 36 showing unusual views of Japan's most famous mountain, Fuji. Here the mountain looks tiny in the far distance.
- The Japanese writing on the print gives the titles for the series and this picture—
 Thirty-six views of Mount Fuji/On the high seas in Kanagawa/Under the wave.
- Mount Fuji is the highest mountain in Japan. With its snow-capped top, it is seen as both beautiful and sacred.
- As the white crest of the wave breaks, it forms grasping fingers that head down toward the boats.

- The picture shows the power of nature, with the boats and fishermen helpless beneath the wave.
- In Japan, pictures are viewed from right to left. Seen this way, the wave looks even more threatening, with the boats heading straight into it.
- The blue color was made from Prussian blue, a dye invented in Germany. The color was popular with Japanese artists for its depth and long-lasting nature.
