1. Hold the page pattern-side down. Take the bottom right-hand corner and fold it diagonally upward in a valley fold, as shown.

2. Fold the bottom left-hand corner point upward in a valley fold to create a large V shape.

3. Take the bottom point and fold it upward along the bottom dotted line in a valley fold. Now make a valley fold on the second dotted line. As you bring up the second fold gently tuck in the small triangle-shaped tip into the back pocket.



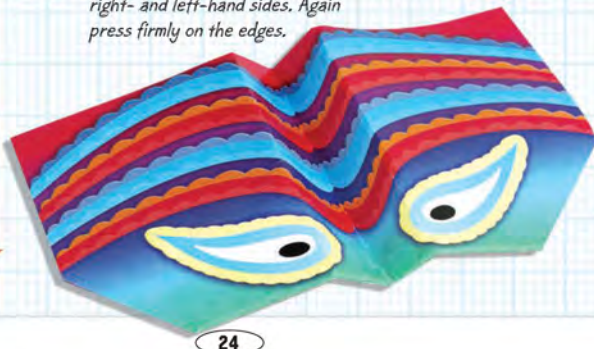
4. Fold the plane in half by making a mountain fold along the dotted line down the middle. Make sure that you press firmly to create a neat edge.

5. Make the two wings by using valley folds to bring down the right- and left-hand sides. Again press firmly on the edges.

Before you fly your Super Swooper, angle the wings slightly upward. Hold it about 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) from the front of the plane and throw it gently angled down.

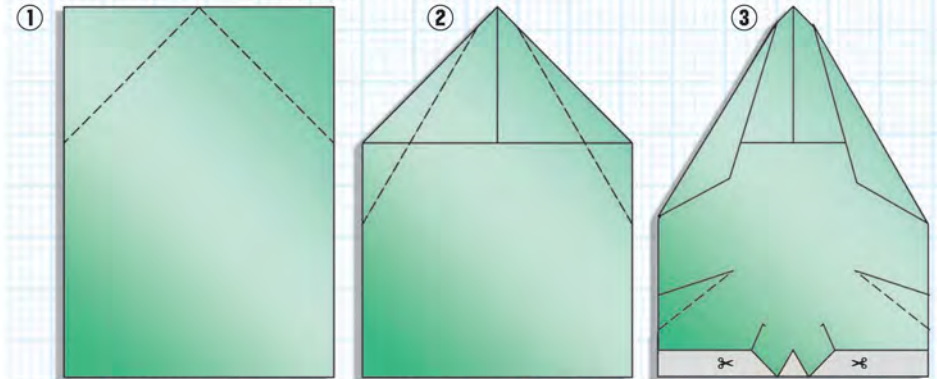

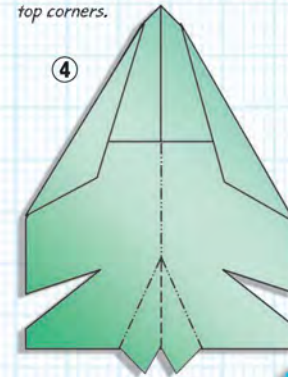

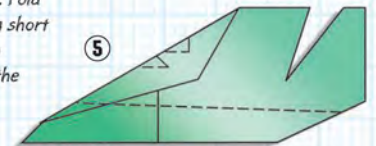
1. Hold the page pattern-side down. Using valley folds, bend in the two top corners.

2. Make two valley folds along the diagonal dotted lines.

3. Using a pair of scissors, carefully cut along the solid lines to begin forming the wings and tail shape. Below the top set of slits, make two diagonal valley folds to create the side tail fins.

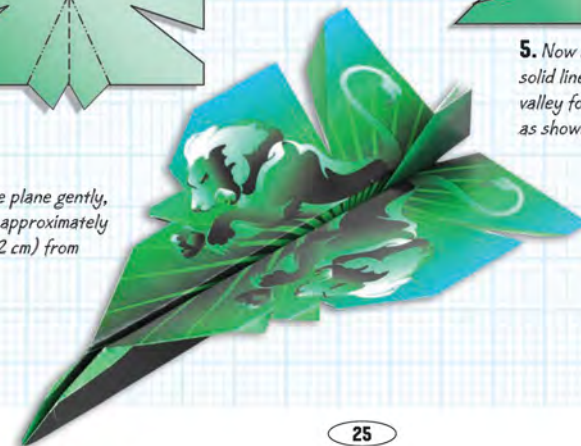


4. Make a mountain fold along the dashed line running down the middle of the plane, then two valley folds either side of this line. Fold the wings over. Then form a short valley fold between the two diagonal mountain folds at the rear of the plane.



5. Now carefully cut along the solid lines on the wings and make valley folds along the dotted lines, as shown.

Throw the plane gently, holding it approximately 4 1/4 in. (12 cm) from the tip.

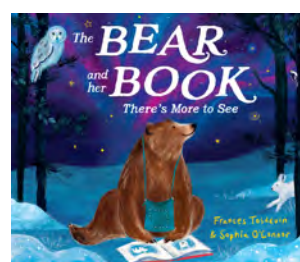

Her debut picture book, *The Bear and Her Book*, was published by Uclan Publishing in October 2021 to critical acclaim.

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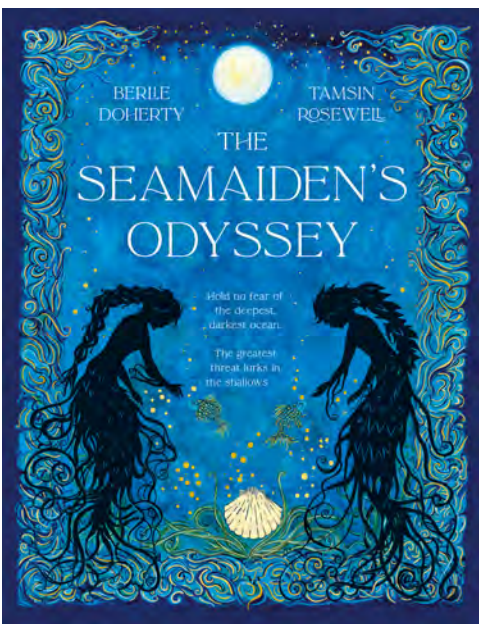

Every year in spring, thousands of people visit Japan to see the cherry trees in flower. The custom of cherry blossom viewing is called *hanami* in Japanese.

This tree is considered one of the most beautiful in the world for its bright pink blossom, which lasts for no more than two weeks at a time.

There are more than 200 different types of flowering cherry trees. Some have white instead of pink blossom.

Cherry blossom has been shown in Japanese paintings for centuries, and celebrated in poetry for more than 1,000 years. The flowers have also long been used as designs for wallpaper and clothing, and today are even used as decorations on cakes and sweets.

In spring, the flowers are picked and used to make a tea. This is drunk at weddings and other occasions representing new beginnings.

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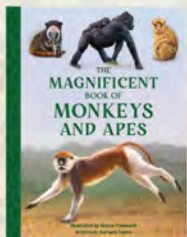

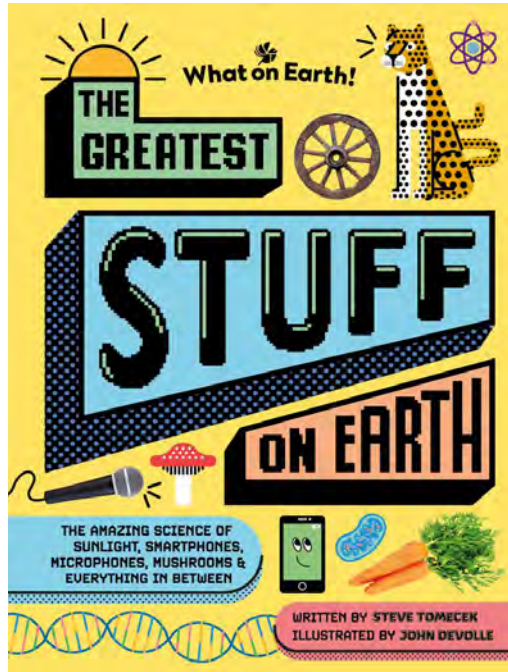

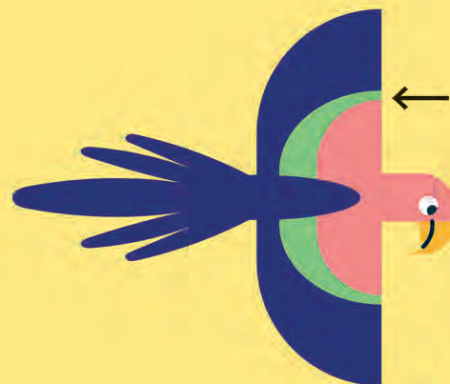
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THE COOLEST FEAT - LIFE

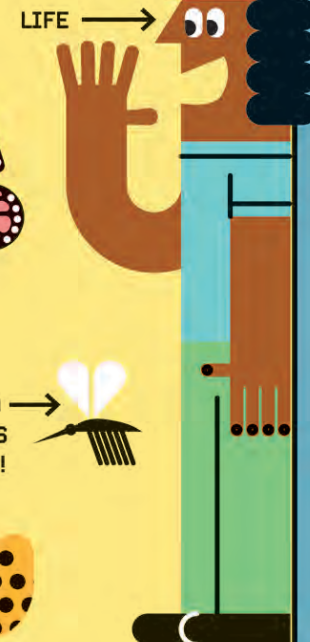
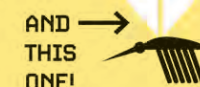
