Weather is the condition of the atmosphere—temperature, precipitation, humidity, wind—at a given place at a given time. Climate, however, is the average weather for a particular place over a long period of time. Climate is not a random occurrence. It is a pattern that is controlled by factors such as latitude, elevation, prevailing winds, temperature of ocean currents, and location on land relative to water. Climate is generally constant, but human activity is causing a change in climate patterns.



According to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), it has been about 50 years since Earth's average temperature was colder then average. Record-breaking heat has become more common as Earth's average temperature continues to rise at an accelerated place.


