Tubman was born enslaved, was torn from her parents and assigned dangerous work from the age of six, and suffered a brain injury in her teens. Despite it all, she developed a rich understanding of nature and a deep spirituality, using them to free herself, to lead hundreds of others to freedom, and – during the Civil War – to be the first woman in the U.S. to lead soldiers on a military mission. In *Harriet Tubman*, *Force of Nature*, Caroline Brewer's beautiful words and pictures take children on Harriet's incredible journey that changed the world.

In primary school I joined an after-school science club, run by a very kind and enthusiastic retired engineer. I learnt to solder which is where you join two things together using molten metal.
