Sometimes they are internal, and no one else can know what we are feeling, thinking, and experiencing unless we communicate it. Facial expressions can give us a clue. Each of the six core emotions can be felt at varying levels of intensity, and the intensity with which we feel any one of the six core emotions creates a new emotion. When we consider intensity when labeling emotions, we quickly expand from the six core emotions to a spectrum of hundreds.





CHOCOLATE ORANGE BREAD PUDDINGS

MAKES 2 BREAD PUDDINGS | TAKES 25 MINUTES

This rich dessert is the perfect way to round off a meal.

INGREDIENTS:

Butter, for greasing

2 eggs

200 ml milk

30 g caster sugar

1 tsp vanilla extract

1 tsp grated orange zest

30 g chocolate chips

120 g stale white bread, cut into cubes

EQUIPMENT:

2 ramekins

- Prepare the ramekins by dipping a piece of kitchen roll in butter and rubbing it around the inside of each pot until they are evenly coated in butter.
- Crack the eggs into a jug and whisk with a fork. Add the milk, sugar, vanilla extract and orange zest to the bowl and whisk together until all the sugar has dissolved.
- Arrange a layer of bread cubes in the bottom of each ramekin and sprinkle over some of the chocolate chips.
- 4 Pour enough of the egg mixture into each ramekin to cover the cubes.
- 5 Add the remaining cubes of bread and chocolate chips on top. Press gently on the bread cubes to help them absorb the mixture.
- Pour over the remaining mixture to fill the ramekins. Don't fill them right to the top as the bread puddings will rise a bit.
- Preheat the air fryer to 160°C/325°F for 5 minutes.
- Use tongs or oven gloves to carefully place the ramekins into the air fryer basket. Set the temperature to 160°C/325°F and the timer for 10 minutes.

CHEF'IT UP!

Experiment with different flavours. Replace the chocolate chips with raisins or other dried fruit or why not try using leftover tea cakes or hat cross buns instead of bread?

- When the time is up, open the air fryer. The puddings should look crisp and golden on top. To check they are cooked through, push a knife into the middle of one pudding and pull it out. If the knife comes out clean with no wet mixture on it, the puddings are ready. If the knife comes out with wet mixture clinging to it, cook for 2–3 minutes before checking again.
- Carefully remove the puddings from the fryer using longs or oven gloves and leave to cool for 5 minutes before serving.
