
WHAT COULD TAKE 500 YEARS TO DECOMPOSE IN A LANDFILL?

The result is a set of beautifully drawn trees and birds - each of which is a small cosmos in itself. Singad's reflections on his paintings take the reader through both nature and the world of art. JAMBU SINGAD is from the village of Balwon, Jhabua District, in the state of Madhya Pradesh. His ancestors were originally forest-dwellers and hunter-gatherers, and some amongst them settled into agriculture at some point in time. For some time now, Bhil people have moved away from their villages to cities in search of work, though they retain close ties to their homes.

Jambu works as a gardener in a museum in the city, and paints in his spare time. But he returns home to farm, when needed. This is his first book.


BIRD CALLS AND CONNECTIONS

Birds call out for many reasons – many times we don't know why. Some calls are harsh, and some are sweet. In our community, there are several beliefs around bird calls. They are part of a relationship which we call *saanjha* – a connection between certain signs from nature and events that occur.


For instance, when a certain small black bird named *sadi* calls out, it is said to announce the arrival of guests. It sings a sweet song, as though it is sending out an invitation; so if we hear the call of a sadi bird, we prepare for visitors to arrive. The sadi is a favourite of mine.

Another favourite is a koel or cuckoo, which also sings a very melodious song. Some people believe that this song will bring rain. You can hear a koel, but it is rare to see one. Sighting a koel is considered lucky, so here is a whole group of koels calling out from a forest of young trees.

Even though we can never be sure about the reasons for a bird call, we can be certain that there is saanjha.

No one knew of the islands' existence before now, and there is not a human being in sight! The newcomers have named the island group Hawai'i. This is a Polynesian term for "homeland". It is also and a reference to the mythical fisherman and navigator Hawai'i Loa.

After leaving their homeland, the Marquesas Islands in the South Pacific, the brave seafarers crossed 2,000 miles (3,200 km) of open ocean. These people have a long tradition of boat-building. To make the trip, they built wa'a canoes, which are very large and sturdy, and have two hulls and one or two sails.

On clear nights, the travelers used the stars to guide them on their way. By day, they followed the migration patterns of birds. They also relied on their expert knowledge of ocean currents to get where they wanted to go.

This is not the first time Polynesians have set out to explore new territory. Many generations of this culture have traveled the South Pacific. They colonized numerous islands, including Fiji, Tonga, and Samoa. Yet it seems this is the farthest north that the explorers have ever traveled.

As with earlier expeditions, this latest includes entire family groups ready to settle on whatever inhabitable islands they find. Now that they have arrived safely in the Hawai'ian Islands, the group plans to stay and make a new life here.

Wind is air moving in a current. When it's warm, the air expands, gets lighter and floats upwards. Colder, heavier air flows in to replace it and becomes wind! This is why breezes feel chilly.


Hurricanes, cyclones and typhoons are different names
